## Charter Revision Commission Special Meeting Minutes

## Town Hall Conference Room

- 1. CALL TO ORDER: Mike Ninteau called the Meeting to order at 7:05 Present: Chairman Mike Ninteau, Keith LaPorte, Karen Buffkin, Harold Nelson, Paula McDowell and Sandra Tremblay.
- 2. MINUTES: Motion to approve minutes of March 29, 2023, by Harold Nelson, second Keith LaPorte. Moved Unanimously
- 3. Finalize draft charter revision based on recommendations received from the Board of Selectmen. (BOS) From their May 2, 2023, meeting.
- BOS: Reconsider the Commission on Aging's charge with the suggestion by the Board of Selectmen that the Commission be advisory-only and that oversight of the Senior Center and the Senior Center Director fall to the chief executive officer of the town and or the Board of Selectmen.
- Charter # 8.1.1 The Senior Center Director shall have the day-to-day responsibility for the operation of the Senior Center and work under the direction of the Town Manager.
- BOS: Clarify the intent of the Charter regarding compensation for elected officials such as the Treasurer.
- Charter # 10.1 Compensation and reimbursement. Unless otherwise provided in the Charter (or by law) regular and alternate members of elective and appointive, and non-hired officials, shall serve without compensation.
- BOS: Consider the inclusion of provisions regarding the process for appointing an acting or interim town manager in the event of vacancy or incapacitation or unavailability of the town manager
- Charter # 5.1 In the event of a vacancy in the position of the Town Manager, incapacity or long-term absence of the Town Manager, the Board of Selectmen can appoint a Town Manager to serve on an interim basis.
- Charter # 5.2 In the event the Town Manager is unavailable to perform their duties for a brief period due to absence or illness for a short duration the Town Manager shall designate an acting Town Manager to serve.
- BOS: Reconsider the proposal for the Annual Town Budget to automatically go to referendum instead of being voted upon at Town Meeting.

Charter Commission: The consensus was no change. The Commission felt this question should be a ballot question.

4. Vote regarding sending revised Charter to Board of Selectmen.

The Lebanon Charter Revision Commission voted unanimously in favor of these changes.
