
## LEBANON'S OPEN SPACES AND TRAILS

In addition to the almost 6,000 acres of preserved farmland which provide many scenic vistas, Lebanon has 15 miles of town gravel roads good for walking and over 3,000 acres of pristine open space where residents can enjoy walking, hiking, biking, horseback riding, boating, fishing, and hunting. Where hunting is permitted please wear blaze-orange clothing (October trough December).

## **MAP KEY**

- 1 Airline Trail State Park. Former railbed with 8-mile flat stone dust path running through woods and farmland. Trail connects to the north to Putnam and to the south to East Hampton. Trailhead locations at (A) Lebanon Ave. in Hebron, (B) Leonards Bridge Road, (C) Chesbro Bridge Road, (D) Trumbull Highway, (E) Cook Hill Rd., (F) Village Hill Rd., and (G) Kingsley Rd.
- **2** <u>Barstow Road</u>. State-owned access to Yantic River for fishing.
- 3 Bartlett Brook Wildlife Management Area. 730-acre State property with trails, hunting, stream fishing, and horseback riding permitted. Access from Lebanon Ave. & Goshen Hill Rd.
- 4 <u>Brewster Pond</u>. State property allows fishing and non-motorized boats. Access from Old Meetinghouse Road.
- **5** <u>Commons Hill Trail</u>. 2.5-mile roundtrip hike on blazed trail with great views. Access from Trumbull Highway at Liberty Hill Cemetery.
- 6 Connecticut Forest and Parks Assoc. 85-acre forest with 1.5-mile trail loop. Access from Oliver Rd.
- 7 <u>Lebanon Town Green</u>. 1.5-mile flat stone-dust path around historic Green
- 8 <u>Lake Williams Pond State Park</u>. 176acres. Non-motorized boating, hiking, and fishing. Access from Exeter Road.



- **9** <u>Mooween State Park</u>. 577-acres that includes Red Cedar Lake. Fishing, non-motorized boating, hunting, and hiking permitted. Access from Camp Mooween Road and Scott Hill Road.
- 10 Nature Conservancy. 66-acres with no trails located on both sides of Tobacco Street.
- 11 Pease Brook Wildlife Management Area. 207-acre State property located on Horiska Road. Hunting and trails.
- 12 Pigeon Swamp Preserve. 136-acre property owned by Joshuas Trust off Pigeon Swamp Road in Windham. Trails.
- 13 Pomeroy State Park. 200-acres. No entrance. Access from Beaumont Highway via utility right-of-way. Hunting.
- 14 Savin Lake. State-owned. Fishing and non-motorized boats permitted. Ample parking off Norwich Avenue.
- 15 Five-Mile-Rock Trail. Town easement across private land from Randall Road to historic Five-Mile Rock.
