Motion carried. **Motion** by Nick Poppiti to charge soccer and little league a \$500.00 fee for use of the facilities at the fields. Motion failed (no 2nd).

3. Field bleachers – **Motion** by Robert Gentes, 2nd Sue Smith to spend up to \$5,000 for bleachers and pads. Motion passed unanimously.

4. Picnic tables – **Motion** by Robert Gentes, 2nd Nick Poppiti to spend \$250.00 for picnic tables for the Pavillion. Motion passed unanimously
5. Volleyball system at Elementary school – **Motion** by Robert Gentes to spend up to \$6,000 on two Volleyball systems for the Elementary School Gym, 2nd Sue Smith. Motion passed unanimously. Ammendment: \$7,000.
Motion by Nick Poppiti, 2nd Robert Gentes to spend up to \$600.00 for Volleyball equipment. Motion passed unanimously.
6. Discussion of hiring two 15 year old lifeguards for the Town Pool. Committee was not in favor of hiring lifeguards age 15.
