

Town of Lebanon Cemetery Commission Regular Meeting Tuesday, May 17, 2016

Members present: H. Wayland, K. LaPorte, M. Lang, R. Parker, P. Maffiolini. Also present: Sexton M. Schuett, Building Official Jason Nowosad, and J. Reichard, Recording Secretary. Members absent: K. Wentworth and S. McCarthy.

Meeting called to order at 7:01 P.M. by Chairman H. Wayland. It was agreed to move agenda item "P" to be first, as Jason had another meeting to attend. The design contract for the new cemetery has been signed by the Selectmen. Base mapping and design work is going on and CME wants to meet with the Commission prior to presentation of 3 conceptual plans. The Commission can choose one and comment; then revisions will be made. The plan will show drainage, driving paths, and all types of plots, etc. Jason recommended asking for graduated cost. Motion by K. LaPorte, seconded by M. Lang to schedule a special meeting for the third Tuesday in June, passed unanimously.

Motion to approve the minutes of the March 15, 2016 regular meeting, the March 31, 2016 special meeting, and the April 26, 2016 special meeting was made by K. LaPorte, seconded by R. Parker, and passed unanimously. Sexton Report: Marcia is still waiting for the Cassidy bill for pumping out a grave. At the end of this week there have been 5 cremations and 3 full burials. There are 6 plots left on the north side of New Lebanon Cemetery. Mulch will be gotten for Trumbull. Jim Hallene did a nice job on the brush in Goshen. So far only New Lebanon has been mowed. Flags are not all in yet. Jason exited the meeting.

Old Business: Members will meet at 3 P.M. next Monday to repair 5 stones in Exeter. Nothing new on stainless steel markers; two more are ready to install. Howard mentioned the company calls him about the lime application, but we cannot afford to do it. Marcia will talk with Phil Chester and maybe Prides will help. Tree removal at Liberty will be next week. Howard will take before and after pictures. Jimmy Mather will start work on the Exeter Hearse House next week. Cedar trees in Exeter need trimming back. Howard said the Commission did not get the \$10,000.00 that was asked for; we got \$3000.00 for FY 2016/2017. Chips from tree work will be used on the Schalk Rd. trail. Howard will arrange to have the remaining bills for this fiscal year paid. Marcia said someone has glued a plaque back in place in New Lebanon.

Motion to adjourn by K. LaPorte, seconded by R. Parker, passed unanimously at 7:44 P.M.
