

**LEGAL NOTICE
TOWN OF LEBANON
ANNUAL TOWN MEETING**

Pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes Section 7-1, et seq., public notice is hereby given to the Electors and those qualified to vote at town meetings of the Town of Lebanon that the Annual Town Meeting will be held on Monday, May 5, 2014 at 7:30 P.M. in the Lyman Memorial High School Auditorium, 917 Exeter Road (Route 207) Lebanon, Connecticut, to consider and act upon the following:

1. Consider and act upon approving the proposed 2014–15 Fiscal Year budget for the Town of Lebanon in the amount of twenty four million forty one thousand four hundred and eighty dollars and no cents (\$24,041,480.00) for the General Town Government, Board of Education, Special Revenue Accounts and Capital Expenditures with Revenue Estimates of seven million four hundred forty four thousand two hundred and eight dollars and no cents (\$7,444,208.00) and the remainder to be raised by taxes with an estimated mil rate of 28.2 mils, representing a 2.16% increase in the amount to be raised by taxes.
2. Consider and act upon approving the 2014-15 Fiscal Year Capital Improvement Program (CIP) as proposed by the Board of Selectmen.
3. Consider and act upon authorizing the purchase of one (1) acre of land owned by Edward D. Keefe located at 903 Exeter Road, in the amount of one hundred thousand dollars and no cents (\$100,000.00), funds to come from Fund Balance, for the purpose of providing additional acreage to the school property.
4. Consider and act upon approving “An Ordinance Repealing the Ordinance Creating a Municipal Flood and Erosion Control Board for the Town of Lebanon and Designating the Board of Selectmen as the Town’s Flood and Erosion Control Board” as per CT General Statutes 25-84.
5. Consider and act upon approving “An Ordinance Withdrawing from the Windham Regional Council of Governments, Repealing the Ordinance Entitled ‘An Ordinance Establishing a Regional Council of Governments’ and Joining the Southeastern Connecticut Council of Governments.”
6. Consider and act upon authorizing the transfer of one hundred one thousand six hundred and one dollars and forty seven cents (\$101,601.47) from Fund Balance to Capital Fund 220, Roads and Bridges, for the purpose of closing out prior year project deficits.

Consider any other business proper to come before said meeting.
