

**LEBANON BOARD OF EDUCATION
SPECIAL MEETING - STUDENT DISCIPLINARY MATTER
MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 13, 2010**

Call to Order: 6:05 p.m. by Donna Lafontaine for the purpose of conducting a student expulsion hearing.

Motion: D. The Superintendent of Schools is hereby directed to offer the Student an alternative educational opportunity within the meaning of §10-233d of the Connecticut General Statutes. Second: L. Jahoda.
