## LEBANON BOARD OF EDUCATION SPECIAL MEETING - STUDENT DISCIPLINARY MATTER MONDAY, AUGUST 30, 2010

**Call to Order:** 6:38 p.m. by Donna Lafontaine for the purpose of conducting a student expulsion hearing.

- 1. The Board of Education adopts the Findings of Fact discussed in Executive Session concerning the student who was the subject of the expulsion hearing conducted in executive session.
- 2. Said student, as a consequence of the factual findings adopted by the Lebanon Board of Education, be expelled from participating in any phase of the Lebanon Public School District's educational program for 180 school days (i.e., the 2010-2011 school year). This includes expulsion from any and all school sponsored or school related curricular and extra-curricular classes, activities, programs, ceremonies, whether at school or other locations.
