

**LEBANON BOARD OF EDUCATION
SPECIAL MEETING - STUDENT DISCIPLINARY MATTER
TUESDAY, APRIL 1, 2014**

Call to Order: 10:00 a.m. by James Mello for the purpose of conducting a student expulsion hearing.

It is the intention of the Board to conduct the expulsion hearing in Executive Session.

Motion: A. Based upon the foregoing facts, the members of the Board of Education who were present at the hearing, upon motions duly made and seconded, voted unanimously (3-0) that:

The Lebanon Board of Education accept the Stipulated Agreement entered into between the Administration of Lebanon Public Schools and the Parents of the student who is the subject of the hearing, regarding the commission of an expellable offense by the Student and the Student's expulsion from the Lebanon Public Schools for one calendar year, and her possible early return to the Lebanon Public Schools on at the start of the 2014-2015 school year.

Moved further that the content stipulated agreement be made a part of the student's cumulative educational record.
