Discussion: Superintendent Angeli informed us that the Board of Education lawyers looked over the contract. The work going forward contains three phases, the inspection of the roof material condition, the structural inspection by engineering firm and the return of energy to Eversource power lines. Nicole McGillicuddy asked if there were any costs to us and the representative from Earthlight Technologies said "No". Trees growing adjacent to the schools should be removed to prevent damage to the roots. This would also open more roof space for the solar panels. This would be a Board of Education expense.

2. Motion made by Bert Bosse and seconded by Mary Ellen Wieczorek to approve and authorize the Superintendent to sign the ZRECAgreement between the Connecticut Light and Power dba Eversource Energy and the Lebanon Board of Education to continue the feasibility study of the solar panel project at the Lebanon Middle School.
