

**LEBANON BOARD OF EDUCATION
SPECIAL MEETING - STUDENT DISCIPLINARY MATTER
WEDNESDAY, MARCH 16, 2011**

Call to Order: 5:00 p.m. by Melissa Hofmann for the purpose of conducting a student expulsion hearing.

A motion was made by L. Jahoda and seconded by D. Battye, “that the Lebanon Board of Education accept the stipulated agreement entered into between the Administration of the Lebanon Public Schools and student who is the subject of this hearing regarding the commission of an expellable offense by the student and the length of the student’s expulsion from the Lebanon Pubic Schools. Moved further that the content of the parties’ stipulated agreement be made part of the student’s cumulative educational record. Motion passed unanimously.
