**I. Call to Order**

S. Haynes called the meeting to order at 5:47 p.m.

**II. Discuss budget implications on curriculum throughout District**

K. Mozak-Pezza reviewed curricular impact of staffing. LES will not be impacted by any changes. LMS - 6th grade team reduced by 1 teacher. Class sizes will remain the same. Only change will be Social Studies will now be taught by each of the 3 6th grade teachers. LMS - Music reduced by 0.4 FTE. Lessons will be consolidated into fewer groups. LMS - Math addition of 0.4 FTE. Schedules are still being worked on. Lyman - PE reduced by 0.4 FTE. Minimal increase in students per class. Lyman - Music reduced by 0.6 FTE. Classes will be changed from 3 sections to 1 section. of 20 students. Lyman - Spanish reduced by 0.4 FTE. Minimal increase in students per class. Lyman - Math reduced by 0.4 FTE. Minimal increase in students per class. Largest class is Geometry with 22 students. Discussion on potential program impacts.

**III. Discuss completed work on Portrait of a Graduate in District**

K. Mozak-Pezza provided a brief overview of the history of work on the Portrait of a Graduate. There are 6 different areas of the Portrait. The qualities listed are written in a manner to apply to any teacher for any grade level. Results from a survey of District Staff members were distributed. Benchmarks will be established soon.
