Cote responded it could or the school library computers could be used. Superintendent Angeli noted this would be the first reading tonight for the Board and it will be on display for a month at the Jonathan Trumbull Library. It will be adopted at the July meeting.

K. Mozak-Pezza noted there will have to be a Curriculum Subcommittee meeting in July.
