2. Joyce G. – LMS team leaders back, little items falling between the cracks because of lack of attention/liaison between teachers, parents, principal.
3. Molly L. – pursue more sending town/ or same towns that currently send VOAG.
4. Rebekah M. – replacement of 15 year old book – obsolete words, and no current words like DVD.
5. Jeannette P. – thanks for funding clubs.
6. Martha S. – monies for library books, grant monies spent in March, little budgeted for 11/12. Book fair not happening – lack of space, volunteers and Martha can't plan it anymore.
7. Scott E. – 20 yr old HS, age showing on equipment like score boards (\$450 for 500 lights in one board) 6-8 boards total, fencing concerns. Will put together a report for end of January; lack of funding for education impacts property values.
8. Edie R. – Can't afford it attitude vs Go for it attitude.
9. Judith I. – kindergarten concerns, reduction in specials will impact "core" growth.

10. Jennifer O. – LES staffing, SRBI etc, small group instruction – 3 going on at once can't supervise.
11. LES – full day kindergarten exploration
12. Mention of state superintendent recommended initiatives of 179 items for Governor and Commissioner to review.
13. Kathleen S. – IA's for grade level not in 12/13 budget, DRA, Aimsweb – safety of students when teacher is out of room testing other students.
14. Suzanne Y. - \$3000 for mulch at LES paid for by PTA, should be in school budget.
