Mr. Walsh reviewed the status of the tracker. Now that school has started new items have begun to be entered. There are currently 19 at the middle school, 12 at the elementary school and 25 at the high school. The summer painting in the 66 wing at the elementary school has been completed. Baseboard will be installed and new blinds are being investigated. CL & P is going to service the soccer field lights as a community project. The small holes in the track have been repaired and the weeds addressed.

The water test at Lyman came back positive for coliform this fall. We are working with the State Department of Health and our water service provider. It is recommended that a filtration system be installed. The approximate cost will be \$16,000.00.

Mr. McGray has met with the administrators to have them review what our buildings and grounds needs are. The Subcommittee will continue to meet on the five year plan.
