I. Call to Order

S. Haynes called the meeting to order at 6:15 p.m.

II. Discuss Next Generation Accountability Report

K. Mozak-Pezza spoke about the update report from 2018-2019 until now. LES did not do as well overall and the test scores were lower. ELA standard 2 has good growth 12-15 pts higher. Math needs improvement, scores were not as high. LMS ELA is stable only fluctuates between 2 points. There was growth in the math scores. Science couldn't compare because the test was a different test. Chronic absenteeism was down. PE was good. Performance gaps are shrinking. Accountability index score has gone up. Lyman scores didn't really fluctuate. They were within 2-3 points. ELA was lower, Math was the same and Science was higher. College and Career courses are up by over 30%. Passing exams dropped by 6%. On track to graduation is up by 2%. P.E. is up a lot.

III. School Strategic Plan Updates

Chronic absenteeism is mostly due to mental health and discipline, which is a concern. Possibly budget a second full time social worker. The strategies for ELA, Math and science include enhancing software and using social emotional learning. Refining benchmark work is in the brainstorming process. LES is working on math revisions, they upgraded envisions program and the math tutor will be coming back now through the end of the year.
