II. Enrollment

The impact of COVID-19 on enrollment has yet to be determined. There was not much information for public schools at this time about enrollment percentages increasing or decreasing. About 20% of kids are not enrolled in college at this time or kids might be going to schools close to home instead of going to their first choices. When the district starts to open there will be more information. Parents may opt out of sending their children to school and might home school them and staff may also do the same depending on what COVID-19 looks like at that time. The district is projecting a decrease in enrollment of about 20 students without the COVID-19 factor. The preschool screenings were virtual and went great. There was no decline due to COVID-19. The estimated 20 student decline is possible because of various reasons which include, families moving out of town, 8th graders may explore tech schools, 12th grade graduates doesn't off-set the incoming students (the senior class was on the smaller side this year). LMS to LMHS is where there is the most loss of students. Twenty students is a lower estimate than normal.
