MINUTES

In attendance: Dawn Whitcher, Bruce Calef, Sarah Haynes, Danelle Person, chair. Andy Gonzalez, Superintendent, Rita Quiles-Glover, Curriculum Director, James Apicelli, Principal.

- I. Call to Order – The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m.
- II. Update on New Courses: Rita presented the courses we will pursue:
 - A. Drone Course: Shane Morse, Lyman teacher will be participating in instructional training throughout the summer with testing and certification to finish. Materials for the course have begun to arrive.
 - B. CNA: Nursing course: A visit date is scheduled by the program coordinator.
 - C. Turf management Course: 0.4 time. We have sampled a curriculum from Southington and a new teacher will help finalize it to meet our needs. Ideas for projects and benefits to our grounds: edging, mulching, fertilizing, overseeding, pruning, mowing, planting. Field trips to UCONN Turfgrass farm, baseball stadiums, American Landscape and Lawn Science. We have had a few applicants for the position already.
- III. Testing: SBAC results come in late June. A report is forthcoming for our July meeting. More results will be shared in our annual report and data dives will take place during August PD to support intervention/ student needs.
- IV. Professional Development Plan: Rita reported an extensive list of PD's planned for the summer. Staff will be busy! Some include: Instructional coaches and pacing, New African American/ Latino coursework, PE Health Curriculum with SEL, PreK DOTS training, LMS Science center visit, Curriculum writing, SPED Scales program, Administrators climate training, ISTE certification for 3 teachers in a 14 week program!
- V. Math Pathways: Rita said that cycle revision is happening to focus on REVIEW, PRESENT (to curriculum leaders/ teams/ BoE), and IMPLEMENTATION. She distributed handouts showing Math for K-5 is heterogeneously grouped but in 6th grade can be divided into two groups based on SBAC teacher rating, and other tests to guide decisions.. High School courses can shift as well, but students frequently follow common sequences. She also shared a pacing calendar for the new i-Ready Math curriculum. There will be website updates to share curriculum documents and information this summer.
