I. Call to Order

N. McGillicuddy called the meeting to order at 6:02 p.m.

II. Subcommittee Goals

1. Status of sending towns – Norwich (not interested), Columbia (bringing to Board if we can become a choice school), Lisbon (already in), Sprague (will only provide transportation for reg. ed kids if there are Ag kids going so they can use one bus), Windham (no response), Canterbury (have not reached out yet).
2. Full day pre-school – Superintendent Gonzalez had conversations with Killingly and EASTCONN. We are still in need of gathering more info., specifically on charging tuition, administration, and interest among the community.
3. Alternative High School – we will continue to gather info., specifically the location of the school.

III. Status of current classroom sizes

The average number of students in all classes K-8 is under 20. The current first grade has the smallest amount of students at 55. Superintendent Gonzalez will continue to advocate for small class sizes in grades K and 1.

IV. Ongoing recruiting efforts

J. Apicelli reported on the ASTE Program application deadline (Jan. 13). He also reported on outside towns sending students for tours/shadowing, and the need to integrate both LMS and Lyman students to promote interest in attending Lyman.
