LMHS Social Studies teacher, Kevin Brodie explained the rationale for new textbooks.

- AP Government course approved: <u>Government in America</u>; <u>People</u>, <u>Politics</u>, <u>and Policy</u>
 College Board has changed the AP Government and Politics Curriculum, so current textbook is now out of date.
- Problems of Philosophy: ECE approved: <u>The Big Questions</u>
 Provides an overview of the philosophical concepts that will be explored in the readings of Plato, Descartes, Kant and Mill. Provides a basis for understanding before students tackle the difficult material in original writings.
- Grade 7 Social Studies: <u>Angel on the Square</u>-Novel
 Historical fiction novel based on Russian Revolution, a topic taught in the 7th grade curriculum. Novel offers opportunity for students to see humanized impacts to correlate with non-fiction text.

Discussion of the "Textbook Evaluation Rating Form for ELA for Grades 3-12." This may or may not be the evaluation form continued to use district-wide.

Motion made by D. Whitcher and seconded by S. Haynes to recommend the textbooks and novel to the Board of Education. Vote: unanimous, Motion passed.
