Presentation of Next Generation Accountability Report According to State data, there is an achievement gap we have been flagged for at the high school reason. This is the reason scholastic level classes are collapsed into College Prep. In the Strategic Plan we have schools score a 1 or 2, but Middle School and High School are at 3.

Physical Fitness: Another area of weakness noted. Students are only required 1 credit in PE and $\frac{1}{2}$ credit in health, Noted that only 10^{th} graders take test, but not all 10^{th} graders take PE. In the future, all 10^{th} graders will take PE.

Discussion of life-long physical fitness and the importance. Discussion of introduction of non-team/competitive sports options.

Discussion of Smarter Balanced Assessments and SAT data trends. Though this data is important, it is only a piece of the decision making process. Observation and collaboration with teachers are huge components.

Change to Grade 3: Writer's workshop began in Strategic Plan 2016. This year will begin Reading Workshop, Fountas and Pinnell Phonics system, Handwriting Without Tears. Although a math focus is needed, teachers have a lot on their plate at the elementary school. Future Math focus is essential. Teachers at middle and high school are undergoing Professional Development opportunities that align with the Strategic Plan.
