- Abigail Smith and her 4-H Leader Amy Smith were present to discuss two projects the local Great Goats 4-H Club is requesting of the Town. The first is to allow the members to plant a flower garden around the flagpole on the Lebanon Green. Abigail presented a sketch and explained details to the Selectmen. The garden will be small in size and the club has committed to installing and maintaining the garden. There will be no expense to the Town.
