1.0 Call to Order

K. Cwikla called the meeting to order at 4:30 PM.

2.0 Discuss and act on 2022 Capital Improvement Plan

The Selectmen reviewed the Capital Improvement Plan. B. Dennler stated the updated plan was developed in conversations with the First Selectman, the Director of Public Works and Facilities, the Town's engineering consultant, and the Finance Director. H. Wagner explained that the plan is needed to receive LoCIP funds under the state's Local Capital Improvement Program. There is currently \$140,000 available to Lebanon with an additional \$70,000 expected next year that could be applied to any of the projects listed. Approval of the CIP does not obligate the Town to undertake or fund any of the projects listed.

K. Smith MOVED to adopt the 2022 Capital Improvement Plan and send it to Town Meeting for approval, included as Attachment A to these Minutes. R. Chesmer SECONDED. <u>MOTION CARRIED 4:0</u>

3.0 Discuss and act on calling the Annual Town Meeting

- 1. Consider and act upon approving the proposed 2022–2023 Fiscal Year budget for the Town of Lebanon in the amount of twenty-seven million ninety-five thousand eight hundred thirty-two dollars and no cents (\$27,095,832.00) for the General Town Government, Board of Education, Special Revenue Accounts and Capital Expenditures with Revenue Estimates of seven million twenty-one thousand nine hundred eleven dollars and no cents (\$7,021,911.00) and the remainder to be raised by taxes with an estimated mil rate of 28.1 mils.
- 2. Consider and act upon approving the 2022-2023 Fiscal Year Capital Improvement Program (CIP) as proposed by the Board of Selectmen.

3. Consider any other business proper to come before said meeting.
