- Liz Shilosky is still working on the flyer that will be mailed to all town residents. At present she is in need of pics of several of the various activities that are going on at the senior center to complete the flyer. We also need to check postal qualifications & requirements for this mailing.

New Business:

- We were visited by Selectman Kevin Cwikla and Town Planner Phil Chester at our meeting. We were informed that the new affordable housing planned near the senior center was still moving forward. A concept plan for the housing should be available by 2023. We were also informed that the market housing (8 units) planned to be built adjacent to the present apartments is still moving forward but was delayed by several factors arising from the pandemic.
- The Commission on Aging plans on being more active in the many planning and discussion meetings going forward in the endeavor to create more available senior housing in our town.
- We were informed that the preparation and paving of our parking lot in front of the garage will be taken care of in the near future.
