Meeting called to order at 6:32 pm by Chairman Bonnie LeBlanc

Approval of Minutes: Marion Russo noted that the date of the Tag Sale needed to be changed to May 7th. Gary Rockefeller moved to approve the minutes with the date revision. Seconded by Geri McCaw.

Treasurers Report: Darcy Battye provided a brief overview of the budget noting that approximately 35% remains in the operations budget and approximately 16% remains in the transportation budget.

The First Selectman's office has suggested 2 minor changes to the Senior Center Policy and Procedure document.

Darcy Battye and Donna LaFountain have been working on the transportation grants and they will be completed and submitted by the due dates.

Bingo: Friday night bingo had a good attendance of 20 participants, Monday was fewer than usual but is going well.

Trips: Marion Russo shared that she just secured a new trip scheduled for July 16th to the new Yankee Stadium to see a Yankees/Red Sox game.
