Whist: Whist resumes on June 24th.

Cards: Setback has been well attended with 44 at last date and a few new members are now coming.

Old Business: The 90 + Birthday Party was a tremendous success with 15 attendees and their guests. It is hoped we can make this an annual event for the senior center. The cost was approximately \$225.

New Business: The year-end budget was presented and discussed. The motion was made to purchase the new stove (up to \$1800) for the kitchen by Donna Lennox, seconded by Marion Russo and approved by all present.
