**I. CALL TO ORDER**

- a. **Motion by Alton Blodgett, seconded by Jon Slate, to approve the February 22, 2024 meeting minutes. Motion approved 5-0-1, with Ethan Stearns abstaining.**

**IV. NEW BUSINESS**

- a. April Litter Clean Up. Marc Lang will contact the Boy Scouts to coordinate litter day pick up activities -- date to be determined. The Commission will place a 30-ton dumpster at DPW to allow residents to place road waste during some or all of April and order garbage bags, safety vests, gloves, and 16 - 36" garbage picker devices from Home Depot -- funds to come from the "nip tax" deposits provided the town.
- b. Rating of New Preservation Projects. The Commission discussed and rated an application for land preservation on Fowler and Waterman Roads that would be open to the public and owned by Joshua's Trust.

**Motion by Alton Blodgett, seconded by Ethan Stearns, to recommend to Board of Selectmen the expenditure of up to \$5,000.00 from the Open Space Account to conduct a land preservation appraisal. Motion unanimously approved.**

- c. Desiree Pearson noted the need to add a trashcan at the north end of the Green to facilitate the deposit of dog excrement.
