 - d. Mia Colasuonno is organizing an application to the Planning and Zoning Commission to designate Randall and Sisson Roads as scenic roads as recommended in the POCD.

 - f. The Commission asked to meet with the Public Works/Facilities Director to discuss maintenance of Town Pound, original Beaumont House site, Town Green, scenic roads, and town trees.
