

An Ordinance Regarding the Approval of Capital Projects

Any appropriation for a capital project which is more than five percent (5%) of the amount to be raised by taxes as set forth in the prior year's annual budget must be approved by a majority of the qualified voters present and voting at: (1) the Annual Town Budget Meeting or at any referendum to which said meeting may be adjourned, or (2) if a petition signed by one hundred (100) or more persons qualified to vote in Town Meetings of the Town is received by the Town Clerk requesting that such appropriation be considered at a special Town Meeting, at such special Town Meeting or at any referendum to which said meeting may be adjourned. Any such petition shall conform to the requirements set forth in Sections 7-9 and 7-9a of the Connecticut General Statutes, as the same may be amended from time-to-time.

This ordinance will become effective fifteen (15) days after publication as provided in Connecticut General Statutes Section 7-157.
