- b) #BUF-09-03: Robin Chesmer, 49 Chappell Road (Graywall Farm), Assessors Map 220, Lot 1. Construction of silage effluent storage basin. IWC site walk took place February 6, 2010, in which the Commission found all to be in order. Mr. Chester reported that an abutting property owner had requested that the Town conduct water sampling on their property. The Commission took no action.

- c) Re-appointment of Members: Mr. J. Bender motioned, Mr. Hallene seconded and the Commission voted to re-appoint John Drum, Robert Slate and Keith Wentworth, as regular members of the Inland Wetland Commission.
