INLAND WETLANDS COMMISSION Regular Meeting

- I. The meeting was called to order at 7:07 p.m. by Chairman James McCaw.
- II. <u>Acceptance of Minutes:</u>

R. Slate made a motion to approve the November 1, 2010, Regular Meeting Minutes, J. Hallene seconded, and members voted unanimously to approve the minutes as presented.

- III. <u>New Business</u>:
 - a. #IW-10-241: Jack L. Rosenblit Revocable Trust, owner, Attorney Mark Rosenblit, 14 Coolidge Road, West Hartford, CT 06117, applicant, Hoxie Rd., Assessor's Map 264/Lot 12. Wetlands filling for driveway construction.

Wesley Wentworth, P.E., Wentworth Civil Engineering, spoke on behalf of the applicant. He reviewed a copy of the original subdivision plan for Hoxie Road. This is a vacant rear lot remaining from property subdivided in the 1980's. A boundary line reconfiguration was approved in the past and the lot now measures approximately 200 feet wide by 440 feet long (driveway additional). He indicated areas of wetlands. When the abutting rear lot driveway was previously constructed, fill was deposited across wetlands for both driveways and culverts were installed. Additional fill may have been removed from the site. Areas abutting development were flagged and he stated an area of minimal overflow will need to be addressed. Fill will be used to widen the driveway and to meet current town ordinance specifications. He stated there should be approximately 500 square feet of wetlands disturbance. The driveway is paved up to the wetlands.

The Commission requested that revised plans be submitted with the following:

- 1) Note be added: "Existing drainage patterns to be maintained."
- 2) Proposed house setbacks from property lines be shown.

This application will be placed on next month's agenda.

- b. IWC 2011-2012 Fiscal Year Budget:
 R. Slate made a motion to approve the 2011-2012 Fiscal Year Budget in the amount of \$2,000.00, J. Hallene seconded. Vote: Approved unanimously.
- IV. Old Business:
 - a. **#IW-10-10:** Myriah Hinchey, owner/applicant, 474 Tobacco Street, Assessor's Map 223, Lot 31. Selective timber harvest and brook crossing. John Drum recused himself from this application.

Mr. Chester visited the site and the crossing had occurred. Mr. Bob Andrews appeared on behalf of the applicant. He stated he made two passes across the brook, seven trees were cut down and the paths were smoothed over with minimal disturbance to any wetlands. DEP and Mr. Chester visited the site and it was agreed that there was no visible wetlands impact. Mr. Andrews stated the work is completed. The Commission clarified application procedures for Mr. Andrews.

J. Bender made a motion to approve the application, C. Bender seconded. Vote: Approved unanimously.

John Drum resumed his seat on the Commission.
