A motion was made to recommend that the Town Planner use Town resources as required for preservation for an appraisal and Class-D survey for property 10-G; seconded and passed unanimously.

Motion: The Conservation Commission recommends that the Board of Selectmen authorize the First Selectman to apply for a 2010 Agriculture Viability Grant for up to \$49,999 as described in the 10/26/10 Town Planner memo; seconded and passed unanimously.

A motion was made to ask the Town Planner to use 2009 Ag. Grant funds to pay for the names on the land preservation plaque, because our budget is nearly empty; seconded and passed unanimously.

Scenic Road Ordinance: tabled. Easement monitoring re-tabled.

Discussed Exeter Brook wetland at Exeter Road. Jan will get more information about phragmites management.
