Jonathan Trumbull Library July 20th, 2017 Regular Meeting – Board of Trustees

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 by the chairman, Cathe McCall.

Director's Report – Julie reported

- DeliverIT (the State Library delivery system between libraries) is back up and running again
- Adult programming:
 - > Book Your Summer this adult summer reading program is going wonderfully well 71 people are registered so far. A \$20 gift certificate to the Log Cabin was awarded as well as a \$10 gift certificate to Farmer's Cow.
 - > Cut-the-Cord was well attended and a handful were here for the Medicare talk
 - ➤ Thru-Hiking the Appalachian Trail will be held on Thursday, August 3rd at 6:30. The facilitator is a retired canine officer who worked in the prison system.

- Claire Levesque-McKinney was hired as Senior Library Aide and begins work on Monday. Seventeen applications came in and five individuals were interviewed.
