Jonathan Trumbull Library September 15th, 2016 Regular Meeting – Board of Trustees

Present: Cathe McCall, Maureen McCall, Michelle Kersey, Kathy Chesmer, Berkeley Nowosad, Mary Withey and Judy Vertefeuille and Library Youth Director and Linda Slate Absent: Diane McCall and Darlene Haynes

The meeting was called to order at 7:05 by the chairman, Cathe McCall.

Minutes to the August meeting were addressed. Motion (Michelle Kersey/Cathe McCall) to accept the minutes as presented. The motion carried with none opposed and three abstentions.

Correspondence – The town would like a proposed meeting schedule for 2017. Motion (Maureen McCall/Berkeley Nowosad) to adopt the proposed schedule as attached and to have the meetings held in the library meeting room. The motion carried with none opposed.

Director's Report – Linda distributed Julie's written report. She said that the report has notes on some of the income and expense items so that this committee is made aware of the current status of those items. Circulation seems to be down compared to last year but if we add the circulation of our books at other libraries as was done last year, that additional 316 would increase the total over last August. The summer reading total for High School was 275 and Elementary and Middle School total was 692. The new adult drawing program (10 attendees for four two-hour sessions) is going well. On November 3rd at 6:30 P.M. author Courtney McInvale will visit. Her new book which came out on 8/29/2016 titled "Revolutionary War Ghosts of Connecticut" has a chapter on the War Office. The press release invites us to "Meet the Spirits of Rebellion Who Haunt the Constitution State." Attendance in the 12 adult programs was 107 and 649 children attended the 40 youth programs from July 1, 2015 to September 15, 2016.

Dawn by Renee Ahdieh) and **HEH! WHAT'S IN YOUR PELLET?? OWL PELLET DISSECTION** for ages 8 to 11 on October 27 at 6:30. Linda attended the LES Preschool Screenings on September 1st at the Grammar School and on October 7th will be attending the Youth Services CLA annual meeting in Wallingford. Julie Culp has a friend whose daughter has created a website for the library and Alicia and Linda have been loading information into it. They are excited that they will be able to update it from wherever they happen to be at the time.
