Minutes

1. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Holly Sinkewicz at 7:02 p.m. in the meeting room of the Jonathan Trumbull Library.

- 2. The group agreed on three individuals who will next be contacted by Julie Culp to come to Lebanon for interviews. These interviews will take place on October 13th; the times will be determined. Holly Sinkewicz will warn the meeting, which will take place at Town Hall, open to the public.
- 5. Julie Culp has received two quotes for the movers of library materials in preparation for the Asbestos Abatement Project, as overseen by the Town. Julie Culp will contact First Selectperson, Joyce Okonuk, regarding a meeting to discuss the quotes and to contact the company that will be agreed upon by them. The Head Librarian has our full support in this proceeding.
