Librarian Reports:

Director's Report: Matt Earls reported.

- The budget will be presented to the Board of Finance in January 2022. An initial meeting of the budget sub-committee will be held in early January 2022 with a follow up meeting later in the month. Matt will reach out to sub-committee members to schedule.
- All indoor activities scheduled for December 2021 were cancelled based on a discussion held during the November 18, 2021 staff meeting and the high number of hospitalizations (over 300) in the state. There is no formal town policy regarding cancellations/rescheduling due to Covid

- so this decision was based on protecting the safety and health of the staff and our patrons. Discussion was held regarding the cancellation.
- CEN (Connecticut Education Network) paperwork has been started. Submission of the same does not commit to connecting to the network and that decision can be discussed at a future date.
- The Friend's Christmas Party, scheduled for December 8, 2021 was canceled due to Covid concerns.
- Matt attended the Connecticut Library Association meeting.
- Stephanie, the current Library aide, is interested in an internship at the Library for her Library certification program.
- Circulation for November 2021 was down 25%.
- Wednesday Walks with Toddlers continues.
- Book discussion, trivia and Dungeons and Dragons have moved on-line.

Youth Services Librarian Report: Maggie Gaier reported (by email)

- Juvenile picture books are the highest circulation statistic and we have had an excellent team effort to keep multiple displays stocked within our small space.
- There are no indoor programs scheduled at the Library for December 2021 and January 2022. Poetry has been moved to Lyman and Turtle Time adapted to Facebook Live.
- Pop-up Outdoor Play with Big Blue took place outside on a sunny but windy day.
- Holiday take-and -make crafts continue to be popular (wooden puzzle, snowflake luminary, beaded wreath, snowflakes to decorate and make your own button).
- Upcoming programs include terrariums, blackout poetry, tiny art show on mini canvases to be displayed at the Library.
- Zoom Opera workshops, cartooning and DND continue, homeschool STEM adapted for Zoom.
- Patrons with birth to 3 have requested outdoor programs continue for socialization and Bundled Babies (Read, Rock and Rhyme adaptation) starts in January 2022 with teen volunteer support.
- Windows and Doors bookclub for teens and adults starts in February 2022.
- Seeds on the Green, a free seed bank coordinated by Plant People will be held in 2022.
