Director's Report: Matt Earls reported.

- Meetings: Planning and Zoning is allowing the tent to be erected at Alden Tavern, which we hope do again next year as well.
- Grants: We need to wrap up our Summer Reading grant details. Scholarship winners were very pleased.
- Moving: Library has been fully moved into new building.
- Grand Opening: There were approximately 350 attendees at the August 20, 2022 event.
   Approximately 500 books were checked out on that day as well.

## Sub-committees/Special Committees:

- Budget (Goba, Dinda, Nowosad, Hadyka): Matt Earls reported. FY 2022 ended (June 30, 2022) \$24,245 under budget. We have received the bill for utilities at the Community Center. For FY 2023, all staff will be encouraged to participate in staff development. \$24,245 will be returned to the Library's fund except that portion from the Mary Adams Trumbull Trust (approximately \$10,000) which should be returned to restricted funds. Matt to follow up with Hayley Wagner regarding the process for that transfer. The restricted funds can only be used to purchase lendable materials and cannot be used for operational expenses. Matt will inquire regarding use of those funds for staff development.
