Public Comment:

Minutes:

- Motion (Janice Knudsen/Michelle Kersey) to approve the minutes of the January 24, 2023 special meeting with two corrections as noted. Motion carried with none opposed.

Librarian Reports:

Director's Report: Matt Earls reported.

- Matt extended his thanks for his experience during the past (5) years as Library Director. Matt has accepted a position with another library and his last day will be March 16, 2023.
- Adult programs include Yoga and Tai Chi which are thriving with regular attendance, the Thursday Magic and Chess clubs are also thriving. We have musicians from the band "Four Strings and a Smile" practicing in the MTA room as well because of the crossover of parents and the Tai Chi group. Book discussion group, mending circle, Arnie Pritchard and Richard Badowski also on going.
- Teen programs include Warhammer, 3D printing and Poetry.
- Friends of the Library has decided to not offer the Equinox and the Arts Show. The new membership coordinator suggested that the Friends determine if they want to raise money or recruit new volunteers. The group overwhelmingly chose to look to increase membership.
- Matt attended the Entertainment Showcase in West Harford which was productive. Musicians, magicians and other entertainers were found at this event.
- We are applying for a \$2000 Summer Reading Grant with a focus on the pollinator garden.
- There is a new monthly brochure design for Library programs.
- Circulation for January was 5492, indicating there are many materials out in the community.
- Maggie has applied to attend the New England Leadership Seminar that Matt attended in 2018 and found to be very valuable. A request for financial support will be forthcoming.
- Also recommended that Maggie attend the Connecticut Library Association meeting for two days and staff (Claire and Shomriel) attended for a day each. A request for financial support will be forthcoming.

Youth Services Librarian Report: Maggie Gaier reported.

- The flow of programming and circulation are both full and lively and we have many regulars who spread the word to friends in surrounding towns that JTL is the place to be.
- We hear parents say daily that “Lebanon has the best library” and that they feel so welcome and supported and valued as community members. We are carving quite a niche for ourselves.
- Lebanon Elementary School field trips are scheduled for March 2023 with over 70 preschoolers visiting JTL on March 24, 2023.
- The first graders at LES raised money for Marcel and her basking area will be renovated with the funds.
- Weekly 3-5 year old Storytime added to calendar as Read, Rock and Rhyme kids are aging out of that program.
- Read, Rock and Rhyme continues to thrive with regular weekly attendance of 25-55 attendees.
- Homeschool Fridays also draw a regular crowd of 25-45 attendees.
- Monthly hike outreach series will draw to a close in March 2023 after 13 fabulous hikes! Maggie intends to have another Friday outreach program following the conclusion of the search for a new Director.
- Friends of the Library donated funds to purchase new in-house toys.
- There is a Meet Up group using our space on Wednesday nights and folks come from all over the state to participate. The group also helps clean up at 5:30 so the Library can effectively close at 6 pm.
- Maggie has also indicated a request for financial support to attend the NELLIS conference with be forthcoming.
- Looking ahead to Matt’s transition, Maggie’s focus will be on hiring, managing operations Tuesday- Saturday and increased delegation to her effective downstairs team.
