 - The Library was awarded a PEG grant for a children's computer with early learning apps in the amount of \$5174.50. Training resources to be pursued by Maggie Gaier through the CT State Library.
- Youth Services Librarian Report: Maggie Gaier reported.

 - \$2000 donated by Friends for Summer Reading performers, prizes and programs; stipend for 2-4 teen volunteers awarded at the end of the Summer as a token of appreciation for their work.
 - Summer collaboration with Congregational Church for their week of Vacation Bible

 - We will be continuing three weekly story times (Monday morning, Wednesday morning and Wednesday afternoon).
 - Friday play times, Swim and Gym in partnership with Aquatics Director and Rec Department.
