I. CALL TO ORDER

Mr. Fields called the meeting to order at 7:04 p.m.

Mr. Jahoda made a motion, seconded by Mr. LaPorte to approve the January 29, 2009 meeting minutes. Motion passed unanimously.

II. NEW BUSINESS - None.

III. OLD BUSINESS

- a. <u>Earth Excavation Regulations</u>. The Committee reviewed Mr. Handfield's 2/26/09 draft. Major proposed changes to existing regulations are the requirement to stockpile separately and preserve prime and important farmland soils, and to perform one (1) soil test per acre or soil map unit. Mr. Jahoda made a motion, seconded by Mr. LaPorte to forward the draft to the Planning and Zoning Commission for consideration of scheduling a public hearing and approval. Motion passed unanimously.
- b. <u>Seasonal Occupancy (Lake Zone)</u>. Mr. Fields discussed his investigation into how other towns are dealing with seasonal properties. The Committee discussed the potential for requiring a new zone designation for Amston Lake because of sewering and the creation of a floor-arearatio requirement at the Lakes. Mr. Chester reported on his conversation with Ann Brown of the Town of Old Lyme and noted he had placed a call to Hebron's Town Planner. The Committee recommended that Commission Counsel prepare a summary of how Coventry and Hebron have dealt with their seasonal occupancy issue, and make recommendations.
