An Ordinance for the Establishment of Regional Animal Control Services

Be it ORDAINED by the electors of the Town of Lebanon at a duly warned Town Meeting held on Thursday July 1, 2010:

<u>Section I</u>: As per Section 22-331a of the Connecticut General Statutes, any two or more contiguous towns, each of which has a population of less than 25,000, may agree to be served by regional animal control services by action of their legislative bodies.

<u>Section II</u>: Accordingly, the Town of Lebanon hereby authorizes the First Selectman to establish Regional Animal Control Services and enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Towns of Bozrah, Franklin and Sprague.

<u>Section III</u>: This ordinance shall take effect fifteen days after publication in accordance with the Connecticut General Statutes.
