REVISED ORDINANCE REGULATING PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON STREETS, ROADS AND HIGHWAYS

Be it ORDAINED by the electors of the Town of Lebanon at a duly warned Town meeting held on Monday August 13, 2007:

That no motor vehicle shall be parked on any street, road, or highway maintained by said Town of Lebanon, during, or for twelve (12) hours following any storm during the period from November 1 to April 1, and to provide that violators shall be subject to a fine of forty-eight (\$48.00) dollars, plus any other fees incurred if is necessary for the Town to remove the vehicle in order to perform its maintenance duties.

This ordinance shall supersede all previous ordinances related to parking on streets, roads and highways.

This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after publication in accordance with the General Statutes.
