Public Works

maintained and is dangerous in the winter. They discussed the possibility of adding signage advising seniors not to use it.

5.0 Discussion with Fire Marshal

Fire Marshal Scott Schuett discussed recent and ongoing inspections of Town facilities. The Department of Public Works, Community Center, and Fire Safety Complex were complete. He said mostly they have found what he called "housekeeping" issues so far. These included the removal of a gas tank and the need for the addition of a heat alarm system which are both being addressed. He said there will be another walkthrough at the Senior Center on September 15. They discussed planning fire drills and emergency evacuations. E. Weinsteiger said she did not believe senior center volunteers would be willing to take on the responsibility of making sure all seniors evacuate.
