Dear Jim and the Library Building Committee,

Per ongoing negotiations with the church, we have hit an impasse. Below we have included three bullets that came from our counsel. After you have an opportunity to review these, the Board of Selectmen would like to schedule a meeting with you and the Library Building Committee.

- The AG unilaterally contacted SHPO in connection with the Church's demands and was told that SHPO will challenge both the Library Building Committee and the Church's plans to add parking to the Green.
- SHPO believes that <u>any</u> additional parking on the Green is "destruction of a public resource" and a violation of the town and church's obligations connected to the National Register of Historic Places.
- In order to avoid the waste of municipal funds dedicated to the Library project, the Library Building Committee needs to submit the plans they have to SHPO right away. All the time and money being spent avoiding SHPO review is detrimental to both projects and the Town.

It is a recommendation from our counsel that the Library Building Committee submit its current plans to SHPO for review.
