



BRIDGE REPLACEMENT CONSTRUCTION
CHAPPELL ROAD CLOSURE

June 11, 2020

Dear Resident:

We are sending this letter to you on behalf of the Town of Lebanon. The Town is planning to replace two bridges in Town which are in disrepair. Anchor Engineering has completed the design for the replacements and the two bridges are located on **Chappell Road** and **Goshen Hill Road**.

Construction will be starting soon for both **Chappell Road** and **Goshen Hill Road**. The bridge on **Chappell Road** is an existing metal culvert with masonry block walls and is located in the area of **200 Chappell Road**, approximately ½ mile east of Route 289. Pazz & Construction, LLC will be the Contractor completing the work. New twin concrete box culverts with concrete wingwalls will be installed to replace the deteriorated metal pipe. A portion of the roadway will be reconstructed on each approach to the bridge and guide railing installed.

To allow the work to be completed in the shortest amount of time, **Chappell Road** will be closed in the area of the existing culvert starting on **TUESDAY, JULY 7, 2020** and is expected to be closed until the end of October. Construction and detour signs will be installed. Emergency and Board of Education personnel are aware of the work and will be updated as construction moves forward. The Town is looking forward to completing these improvements and thanks you for your patience during this temporary travelling inconvenience.
