



BRIDGE REPLACEMENT CONSTRUCTION  
**GOSHEN HILL ROAD CLOSURE**

June 23, 2020

Dear Resident:

We are sending this letter to you on behalf of the Town of Lebanon. The Town is planning to replace two bridges in Town which are in disrepair. Anchor Engineering has completed the design for the replacements and the two bridges are located on **Goshen Hill Road** and **Chappell Road**.

Construction will be starting soon for both **Goshen Hill Road** and **Chappell Road**. The bridge on **Goshen Hill Road** is an existing concrete deck with masonry and concrete walls and is located in the area of **700 Goshen Hill Road**, approximately 1 mile east of Lebanon Avenue. B&W Paving and Landscaping will be the Contractor completing the work. New twin concrete box culverts with concrete wingwalls will be installed to replace the deteriorated bridge. A portion of the roadway will be reconstructed on each approach to the bridge and bridge and roadway railing installed.

To allow the work to be completed in the shortest amount of time, **Goshen Hill Road** will be closed in the area of the existing culvert starting on **MONDAY, JULY 13th** and is expected to be closed until the start of November. Construction and detour signs will be installed. Emergency and Board of Education personnel are aware of the work and will be updated as construction moves forward. The Town is looking forward to completing these improvements and thanks you for your patience during this temporary travelling inconvenience.
