

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING LOITERING

Be it ORDAINED by the Electors of the Town of Lebanon at a duly warned meeting:

Section I. It shall be unlawful for any person to loiter upon the grounds of the Jonathan Trumbull Library, the Community Center or the Town Hall.

Section II. Definitions:

For the purposes of this ordinance, the term loitering shall, without constituting any limitation upon the provisions of Section I, encompass any one or more of the following acts committed on said premises within the Town of Lebanon.

- (1) Obstruction of the free, unhampered passage of pedestrians or vehicles.
- (2) Obstructing, molesting or interfering with any person lawfully upon said premises.
- (3) Idling about, loitering on said premises, except for a legitimate purpose.
- (4) Refusing to move on when so requested, either orally or by the posting of an appropriate notice or in writing by a peace officer, public official or other duly authorized person.

Section IV. Violations:

Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be fined not more than \$100.00 for each offense.

This Ordinance shall take effect Fifteen (15) days after publication in accordance with the General Statutes.
