AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING TOWN ROADS AND THE ACCEPTANCE THEREOF

Be it ORDAINED by the electors of the Town of Lebanon at a duly warned meeting:

Only those roads, or portions thereof, falling into the following categories shall be considered town roads:

- 1. All roads, or portions thereof, appearing on the last list of town roads prepared by the Connecticut Department of Transportation and entitled, "Miles of Locally Maintained Roads as of December 31, 1972, Town of Lebanon."
- 2. That section of Valinsky Road running southwesterly from the Stocking house to the unimproved section of Goshen Hill Road as approved for maintenance as an existing town road at a Selectmen's meeting held on August 6, 1973.
- 3. All of Barker Road as approved for maintenance as an existing town road at a Selectmen's meeting held on March 5, 1973.
- 4. That section of Francis Drive accepted by the Town of Lebanon at a town meeting held on September 6, 1973.
- 5. That section of Pigeon Swamp Road accepted by the Town of Lebanon at a town meeting held on December 20, 1973.

Further, a town meeting vote shall be required to reopen, improve, or accept, as a town road, any other road, old or new, which does not fall into any of the above categories.

This Ordinance shall take effect Fifteen (15) days after publication in accordance with the General Statutes.

The effective date of this Ordinance is March 26, 1974.
