
>If handwriting the application, please write legibly



#### What is the MRF?

The Military Relief Fund (formerly the Military Family Relief Fund) assists service members and their families who live in the State of Connecticut and are experiencing a financial hardship.



# How do I apply?

Applications can be obtained by calling (860) 524-4968 or by visiting the MRF office at the address on the back of this brochure. Applications are also available online at http://www.ct.gov/mil/mrf.

# Who is eligible?

- •Soldiers, Airmen, Marines and Sailors of all branches and components, as well as their spouses, children and parents are eligible for a grant
- •Other family members may be eligible if they resided with the service member prior to active duty service
- •There must be an immediate, quantifiable, financial hardship that is directly related to military duty.
- •Applicants may qualify for assistance after the service member has returned from active duty IF the financial hardship they are experiencing is related to that prior active duty service.

# How much can I receive?

The fund has a cap of \$5,000, but can exceed that cap by a unanimous vote of the MFRF Committee and the hardship justifies a grant exceeding the cap.

# What is the process?

When the application is received, the MRF coordinator will setup an appointment at to review your situation. The MRF Committee will make a decision of YES or NO. For YES votes, they will also discuss and approve a fair grant amount to alleviate the problem.
