1.0 **Call to Order** at 7:32 p.m. by Chairman Hofmann.

### 2.0 Approval of Minutes –

Motion made by B. Handfield and seconded by A. Wilder to approve the Regular Meeting Minutes of 9/8/11. Motion unanimously approved.

- 3.0 **Public Comment** Bill Slover, resident, 440 Deepwood Drive, expressed concerns regarding: 1) What happens to the powering of the grinder pumps during a storm event/power outage. K. Mailman stated that each unit will be equipped with an external generator mount and during a sustained electrical loss a portable pump station will maintain the systems and each system has a 60 gallon tank capacity, equal to approximately 1 day of usage. 2) Is there a tax deduction that residents can take for their assessment and user fees? This is a question for the tax office and there is no certainty as this is a 'utility'. It was noted that fees will not be incurred until after construction in 2013 and the actual amount will be determined at a Public Hearing.
- 4.0 **Correspondence** USDA, Norman St. Jean dated 9/16/2011; Waller, Smith & Palmer, P.C. dated 9/15/2011 and 9/19/2011.

## 5.0 **Project Update**

Kurt Mailman, P.E. provided members with project updates: 1) Bond closed on Friday 9/23/11 at .55%. 2) Lebanon received a favorable compliance review from USDA on 9/16/11; 3) Fuss & O'Neill will forward to USDA a packet, on Friday, 9/23/11, addressing the items WPCA has: Municipal Agreement with Hebron, Blanket Easement, Bioxide Location Easement and 211 executed Easements with approximately 90 outstanding. Items that are outstanding: Colchester Easement. The documents needed by Bond Counsel will need to be reviewed and compiled. J. Hofmann, Chairman will attend the next Regular Meeting of the WPCA in Hebron to thank them for signing off on the Easement. K. Mailman stated that the next steps are conducting the voluntary Pre-bid Meeting on Friday, September 30 at 10 a.m., Town Hall and the Bid opening on October 18.

6.0 **Old Business** – A. Wilder and D. Martin have been pursuing alternative funding to help offset homeowners' costs for the sewer connections. Despite no success with OPM in this regard, they

will continue to work with Lynn Naus, resident and pursue additional avenues for funding – STEAP Grants; Peter Huckins, Housing Rehab; Block Grants and Tribal Grants.
